- County Honor Band auditions on Dec 1 at SRV.
- Invites have gone out for the Jazz Invitational on Dec 8th. We need to ask an alumni parent to cook lunch for the adjudicators.

- Total Income - \$39,056
- Total expenses - \$19,761

OLD BUSINESS

- **Central Cal Competition:**
 - Need dinner organized for the bus, since we have the playoff game upon return – Dora to coordinate
 - Need snack bags for the Jazz students – 23 kids
- **Assistant Music Director:**
 - Brandt needs travel expenses reimbursed. He is traveling between Windemere, Diablo Vista MS, and SRV. What is allowable?
 - Lora Finko to figure it out. They will give us a number.
 - Thank you to Tommy for helping us!
- **Ike's Fundraiser – Dora:**
 - We made \$200. Appreciate the nice long window of time they gave us (2pm – close).
- **See's Candy Fundraiser – Suzanne:**
 - On track, got all the checks. Funds will transfer on Wed, Nov 11.
 - Participation – 48 students
 - Total sales roughly \$10,000. Estimated profit for Wolf Tones is \$2800.

 - Will need a few people to handle check-in, pizzas
 - Will send a request for lunch for adjudicators
- **2019-20 Registration**
 - SRV Administration is thinking about only one day for registration next school year. It would likely be the Thursday before school which is the same day as our Annual BBQ. They have asked for feedback from Booster groups.
 - Group consensus is that we prefer the current practice of 2 half days for registration, with one early and one later (for working parents).
- **CCC Honor Band Auditions 12/1/18**
 - PAC stage is the audition zone. No one is allowed in the hall. IMR and Choir room will be used for warm-ups.
 - We will need SUG for helpers; print out notecards of how to check the list
 - Other schools will provide dinner in our Commons, since it is technically a non-SRV hosting year
